How to take care of your Stained Wood Furniture

- 1. Always test a small area before cleaning, approx 1x1 in an inconspicuous area to make sure it will not harm the finish.
- 2. Always avoid the use of furniture polishes, dusting sprays or oil soaps as they may contaminate the finish for future recoating.
- 3. Use a water dampened cloth for regular cleaning.
- 4. When cleaning, always wipe with the grain of the wood.
- 5. It's important to use coasters / pot holders to protect your furniture from standing water and heat.
- 6. Although the piece is moisture resistant, leaving standing liquid for an extended period of time WILL cause damage.
- 7. Keep the table out of direct sunlight, which can damage and fade the Polyurethane coating.
- 8. Overtime your piece will wear and tear naturally, depending on how its cared for. When it comes time to needing recoating, I can either: 1. Refer you to a local hardware store to get some reasonably wood sealer 2. Contact me with your name, location and a description of what you need done and I can send you a quote for a service call.
